Dear Vendor (Non-Food),

Welcome to the Annual TEXAS SCOTTISH FESTIVAL & Highland Games (TSF&HG). It will be held on May 6-8, 2022, Friday 5:00 p.m. to 11 p.m., Saturday 10:00 a.m. to 11 p.m. and Sunday 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Location: Wise County Fairgrounds, Decatur, TX, 3101 FM 51 - Decatur, TX 76234

Vendor Area: The vendor area is varied including a natural grass field. 2022 layout will vary slightly from 2021 as we work to develop the pedestrian traffic patterns in our location. For our returning Vendors, we will make every attempt to place you in the same location as last year.

Registration: Vendor locations will be prioritized by receipt date of your deposit, confirmation will not be accomplished until after the final payment is received and not until after April 1st. We highly recommend early set-up. Spaces will be ready by 11:00 a.m. on Friday. You may setup on Thursday if prior arrangements are made with the Vendor Chairman. Check-in will be accomplished there and you will receive your vendor packet and directions at that time.

Enclosed you will find the current Vendor Information Sheet, the Vendor's Space Description and Vendor's Registration Form which has the schedule of fee's for the Festival, also an Ad Rate Schedule and maps of the grounds.

Electricity: Electricity is limited and only available at specific locations with payment and prior arrangement. We will do everything we can do to accommodate your needs.

Safety, Security & Vehicles on Site:

All motorized vehicles must be off the field by 4:30 p.m. on Friday and 8:30a.m. on Saturday--no exceptions. Because of the new venue/layout trailers may not be allowed adjacent to your spots. Vehicles will not be allowed on the field between 8:45a.m. on Saturday and 6:00 p.m. on Sunday. The vehicle rule will be strictly enforced. Remember vendors have the prime locations and you must look appealing to the public. You are expected to be setup and ready for business by Public Opening each day and remain open until 9:00p.m. on Saturday and 6:00 p.m. on Sunday. Friday you may close early if you choose. Security is provided, but ultimately YOU are responsible for the security of your own merchandise. Also because of the new venue we will now offer RV parking (free to vendors) inside the fair grounds. Festival Camping/RV registration is required for security.

TSF VENDOR (Non-Food) INFORMATION

LIGHTING - We require that you stay open for business until 9:00 p.m. on Saturday. In this part of Texas, the sun sets at approximately 8:15 p.m. with twilight lasting until 8:30 p.m. With these factors in mind, there is little need for electrical lighting unless you desire to stay open later to take advantage of late shoppers.

ITEMS For Sale - In keeping with the theme of the festival, priority will be given to vendors whose items for sale are of a Scottish theme, Scottish origin, or particularly unique to Scotland or Celtic culture. This includes prime locations!

PROGRAM ADVERTISEMENTS - Place an ad in the festival program for a modest fee. Offer a coupon discount to attract customers to your tent. A fee schedule is included; see the 'Ad Rate Sheet'. Program ads also include TSF social media exposure.

FEES - Fees are stated on the Vendor Registration form. Deposits are due by February 28th and final payment by April 5th. No notice of final payment will be sent. Checks, money orders, online payment via website.

CONFIRMATION OF LOCATION - Location assignments will be made the last week of April. Confirmation of your assigned location will be made by email only after final payment is made. This will be by email only so insure your email is legible on your registration form.

SET-UP - Vendor spaces will be ready by Friday 11:00 a.m. All motorized vehicles must be off the field by 4:30 p.m. - no exceptions. Gates will reopen at 6:30 a.m. Saturday for small setups and restocking. Vehicles will not be allowed on site between 8:45 a.m. Saturday and 6:00 p.m. Sunday. The vehicle rule will be strictly enforced.

VENDOR PACKETS - Will be ready on Friday when you arrive, admission tickets are included. The standard number of tickets for the various sized spaces is stated on the Vendor Space Descriptions Sheet, if you need more, let us know when you register. The packets will be at the TSF Information & T-shirt tent located inside the main entry.

TENT RENTALS - For tent rentals we recommend Alexander Tent Company of Dallas, Texas. Call them direct for rentals @ (972) 247-8556.

TABLE RENTALS - We will arrange for table rentals. Please indicate the number of tables needed on the Vendor Reservation form. These are heavy duty 8' tables @ \$20.00 per table.

INSURANCE - All vendors are required to carry liability insurance. In case of an accident in your area you will be liable for potential damages. Be Safe!

PARKING - is included, passes will be distributed in vendor packets upon arrival.

ELECTRICITY - There is a minimum \$50.00 fee for electrical hook-ups. (Single 110v, low-wattage, extension cord hook-ups) If additional service is required please let us know and we will attempt to accommodate.

Festival outlets overload easily, are not open freely to vendors and must be controlled.

Where generators are used, they must not disturb either your neighbor vendor or the customers of either your booth or neighboring booths. Please communicate with your neighbors to minimize trouble areas, if conflict cannot be avoided, contact the Operations Director, he will eliminate the cause of the conflict.

All extension cords that cross a walkway must be SECURED down; bring your own tape etc. Those not taped and secured safely will be removed.

Bring adequate length extension cords; most distances will be 50 to 100 feet.
